SERBIAN CITIZENS CAN TRAVEL TO EU COUNTRIES WITHOUT VISAS SINCE DECEMBER 19th, 2009



- 3.7 biometric passports issued
- 12 million entries into Schengen space





SERBIA ANSWERED THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION'S QUESTIONNAIRE IN RECORD TIME AND RECEIVED A POSITIVE OPINION



- 22 December 2009 Serbia officially submitted its request for EU membership
- 24 November 2010 Serbia received the European Commission's questionnaire



- **31 January 2011** Serbia submitted answers to 3000 questions from the EC questionnaire
- 12 October 2011 Serbia received the EC's opinion in which it is recommended that Serbia receives candidate status for EU membership with the understanding that existing agreements with Pristina will be implemented

757 MILLION EUROS OF EU GRANTS AWARDED TO SERBIA OVER THE PAST FOUR YEARS



• 129 projects worth 757 million euros accepted for financing in the time period 2008-2011 and are in the process of realization
